#### Specifications of the image:

- · A4 size, printed or developed in color.
- · 4 shots in total (per piece), one each of the front, bottom, close-up, and other highlights of the work.
- \*Please write your name and the direction from which the work was taken in the bottom right section of the back of the envelope.

  Please be careful not to let the ink bleed through the paper.

- \*If you submit a paper photo of your work, it will be converted to a digital image for judging.
- Please note that the quality, color and texture of the original print cannot be adjusted.
- \*If you send your work by mail, please send it by a method that can be tracked by the applicant, such as registered mail, acceptance-recorded mail, or Letter Pack.

# BIZEN CONTEMPORARY CERAMICS BIENNALE 2024

Bizen has been producing pottery for more than 800 years.

The Bizen Contemporary Ceramics Biennale 2024 will be held to provide an opportunity to reaffirm Bizen's value as one of Japan's leading ceramic art cities by inviting ceramic works from Japan and abroad.

This exhibition will explore the possibilities of ceramics,

provide support for artists, and create opportunities for exchange,

with the aim of promoting the inheritance and development of ceramic techniques and culture.

# Eligibility for Application

- · Applicants must be active in the field of ceramics, and must be able to apply for the exhibition in the manner specified by the exhibition.
- · Applicants must be able to deliver and retrieve their works in person.

# Specifications and Limitations

- · Only ceramic works will be accepted. Any type of clay, forming and firing method is acceptable.
- Please submit your own work which has not yet been exhibited.
- Each entrant is limited to one submission. You may submit no more than 5 pieces as a set of works.
- The size of the work must be within 240 cm (height + width + depth) and 90 cm (width or depth when packed). This includes exhibition fixtures such as pedestals.
- · The weight of the work itself must not exceed 30kg.
- · The work must be able to stand on its own (use of assistive devices is allowed).
- Works that hinder the exhibition or delivery of other works will not be accepted.

Works that are easily damaged will not be accepted, and may be returned by cash on delivery even after acceptance.

#### Selection of Works

#### First round: Image screening:

Screening will be conducted on the basis of images.

Applicants or their representatives will be notified of the screening results in writing in mid-August.

Entry guidelines for the secondary screening will be sent to applicants who pass the first round screening.

#### Second round: Artwork judging:

Judging will be conducted on the basis of actual works. Entrants are required to deliver their works in mid-September.

The screening results will be notified in writing to the applicant or their representatives in late September, and will be posted on the website.

#### About the delivery and retrieval of works:

♦ Delivery

The work must be delivered directly by the applicant or their representatives indicated at the time of application.

Works received outside of the designated application period will not be accepted.

Retrieval

The work must be retrieved directly by the applicant or their representatives indicated at the time of application.

We cannot guarantee the preservation of works after the period designated by the exhibition.

All expenses (packing, transportation, travel expenses, insurance, etc.) related to the delivery and retrieval of works are to be borne by the applicant.

#### Notes on the judging process:

Mention Certificate

All judging will be conducted behind closed doors.

- · The judges will not be informed of the applicant's personal information.
- No individual enquiries regarding the screening results will be accepted.
- No objections or requests for clarification will be accepted.
- For applicants residing outside of Japan, result notifications will be sent to you by Email.

However, if you have appointed a representative, the results will be sent to their physical mailing address.
